Ages 6+



Turn me round for the answer!

The true bit: Its biggest teeth were up to 20 cm long. That's 8 inches, so eight really was its number!

Ages 3+



Turn me round for the answer!

The true bit: T. rex had about 60 teeth, and the biggest were up to 20 cm (8 inches) long. That's about as long as a banana!

Ages 6+



Turn me round for the answer!

The true bit: T. rex's arms were short, but they had strong muscles.

Turn me round for the answer!

The true bit: Birds evolved from small meat-eating dinosaurs, the same group T. rex belonged to. So every bird you see is a living dinosaur!

At your bird feeder!

Ages 6+



Turn me round for the answer!

The true bit: "Triceratops" means "three-horned face": one horn on its nose and two above its eyes.

Ages 3+



Turn me round for the answer!

The true bit: Triceratops had a nose horn so sharp, it could probably cut through wood, and a head the size of a small car!

Turn me round for the answer!

Turn me round for the answer!

Ages 3+



Turn me round for the answer!

Ages 3+



Turn me round for the answer!

Turn me round for the answer!

Ages 3+



Turn me round for the answer!

Ages 6+



Turn me round for the answer!

Turn me round for the answer!

Turn me round for the answer!

Turn me round for the answer!

Turn me round for the answer!
The true bit: Some people think it was poisonous, but there's no evidence for that.

Turn me round for the answer!
The true bit: Its jaws suggest it probably ate fish, but it was still a carnivore.

Turn me round for the answer!
